2023 CPT CODE CHANGES FOR TESTING TO MAYO MEDICAL LABORATORIES

Explanation: Annual updates to the CPT (Current Procedural Terminology) and HCPCS (Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System) by the American Medical Association (AMA) and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) require the review and revision of coding for testing services offered.
